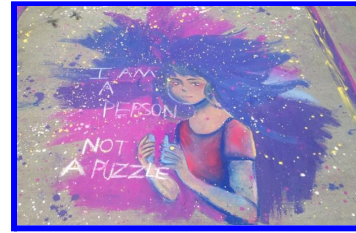


Autistics United Presents: Girls Day Out!

Please remain in the facility while the group is in session. Please remember that if you have to leave we, the A.U. nonprofit, cannot be held responsible for any accidents or issues that may occur. For this reason, it is best to stay on site.
